
Hello Family,

Discussion/questions

Last two ASCs, I brought up a concern about the RD's lack of attendance at the NEZF business meetings in June (though hotel expenses were disbursed for 2 nights). GSRs expressed a desire to address the issue at the September RSC. *I did so during my report.* We ran out of time and the issue was not discussed. It is in the minutes and I have spoken to other RCMs who have similar concerns. ****Will be addressed next RSC by participating RCMs during "Old Business".**

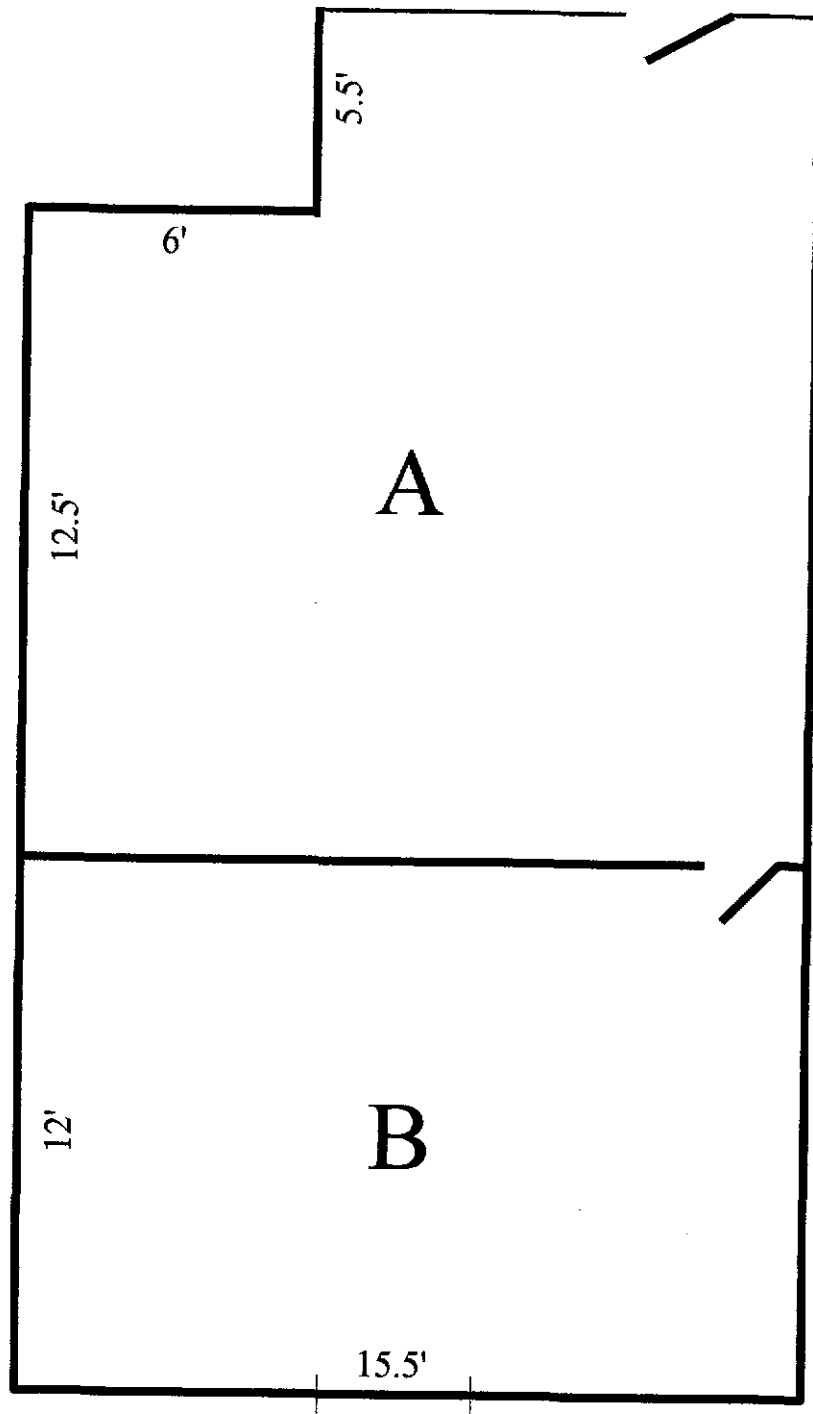
